Behavioral Health Program

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Family, economic, marital, health, and occupational stressors at times produce significant impairment in a person's ability to cope with the demands of everyday life. When this happens, our normal problem-solving skills become overwhelmed and our mental health is compromised.

Our array of services is designed to help you manage your stressors and return to your optimal level of performance. Some of the diagnostic and therapeutic modalities employed are:

Diagnostic Assessment

The counselor gathers information about your concerns, conducting a brief mental status exam, establishes a provisional diagnosis, and suggests a plan of treatment, which may include referring you to other agencies in the community.

Individual Counseling

Meeting with the counselor on a one-to-one basis, the emphasis is on helping you obtain insights, which can enhance your problem-solving and coping skills.

Family Counseling

Our goal is to strengthen families by helping them learn to better problem-solve, improve communication, and increase their ability to understand and support each other's continued growth and development.

Marital Counseling

Counseling helps the couple negotiate differences and strengthen their relationship without either losing their identity. The emphasis is on maintaining respect, even when the decision is to end the relationship.

Group Therapy

This form of treatment is characterized by a great deal of confidential and honest communication that can lead to behavioral and/or attitudinal changes required for greater life satisfaction. Group members themselves play an active role in each other's treatment.

Play Therapy

In working with young children, the therapist utilizes various toys, games, and art to help the child become aware and come to terms with their emotional issues.

Substance Abuse Assessment

The counselor determines if the patient has a diagnosable substance abuse disorder and, if so, what level of care and type of referral is required.

Support Groups

These groups come together for mutual encouragement and support, and to prevent a sense of isolation in their struggle with a common problem.

Educational Services

The counselor provides information to individuals or groups wishing to better understand their particular problem relating to mental health, parenting, or substance abuse.

ACCESSING SERVICES

To receive services, a person must first be registered as a patient of STRHS, Inc. You may request services on your own or your doctor may refer you. We also accept referrals from outside agencies.

FEES & PAYMENTS

STRHS, Inc.is a provider in several HMO plans and accepts many forms of health insurance including:

- Private health insurance
- Medicaid
- Medicare*

For patients not covered by health insurance, STRHS, Inc. has a sliding fee scale based on your family income and family size.

*For Medicare patients, the deductible is waived and co-pay will be charged according to the Center's sliding fee scale.

The Crossroads Program for Senior Adults is an outpatient mental health program provided by Uvalde Memorial Hospital for senior adults. The program provides the opportunity to improve the quality of life for senior adults who suffer from psychiatric, behavioral, and emotional disorders. The program allows the patient to reduce their distress and increase their ability to function independently in the least restrictive environment and are able to return home each evening.

The Crossroads Program offers psychiatric intervention with a certified staff which include: a Psychiatrist, Social Workers, Licensed Professional Counselors, Certified Therapist and Mental Health Technicians.

PROGRAM INCLUDES:

Group/Family/Individual Therapy, Coping/Positive Learning Skills, Greif and Loss Resolution, Cognitive Stimulation, Reminiscence and Validation Therapy, Stress Management, Assertiveness Training, Education (Medication Management, Health and Wellness Training, and Leisure Planning)



ADMISSION

Referral to the program are open to physicians, health care professionals, human services agencies, clergy and/or family and friends who are concerned with the well being of their loved ones. A psychiatrist, in collaboration with the family physician, will determine the diagnosis and recommend the appropriate treatment prior to any admission to the program. Payment for the services of the program are Medicare and most private insurance plans.


